Description

Native speakers and young learners of English are both familiar with the unforgettable lullaby, "Twinkle twinkle little star". Besides its soothing melody which helps establishing a nice, calm atmosphere it teaches about the night sky and stars.

Focus of the games:

- 1. matching things and shapes
- 2. listening: finding a shape of the correct colour
- 3. tracing the lines of shapes to develop fine motor skills



Activity Ideas

- → Play "I spy with my little eye..." with shapes in your classroom. Organize a race between groups, have them challenge and help each other at the same time.
- → Play "Run and touch" activity in the classroom. Say instructions like "Run and touch a triangle." or combine it with different types of movements: "Hop and touch...", "Walk and touch..."
- → Have some luminescent stars and decorate the classroom. Turn off the lights and sing "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star" under the night sky.
- → Use the memory game below. Cut out the cards and learn the words through this activity. Challenge your learners by cutting off the words.
