Activity Tips

Cartoon

#project #vocabulary #language skills

Ask the learners to create a cartoon which introduces the events and a dialogue between Peter and his mother after his arrival from the garden. Encourage them to use the name of emotions that they already know: upset, sad, brave, disappointed, curious or happy. Learners can use the sentences from Task 3 in the BOOKR Class application.

Writing a letter

#language skills

Ask the children to write an apology letter to the mother including the short summary of the adventure. Encourage them to use Past Simple.

Beatrix Potter's timeline

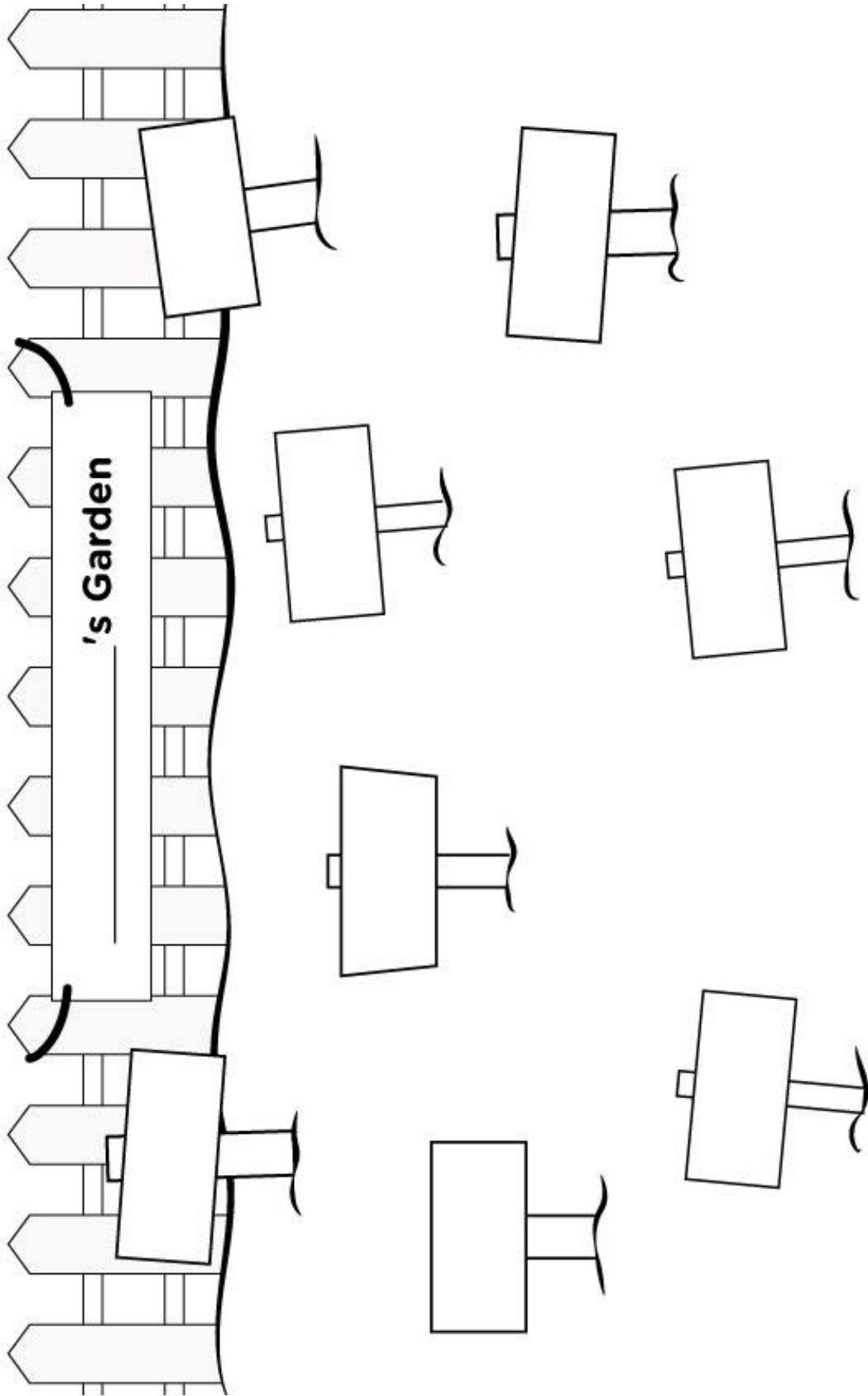
#project #language skills
